*This company was successively designated as Captain Huff's Company, Mississippi Volunteers; Company K, Blythe's Regiment Mississippi Infantry; and Company K, 44th Regiment Mississippi Infantry.

The 1st (Blythe's) Battalion Mississippi Infantry was mustered into the service of the State of Tennessee, May 25 to July 11, 1861, and on Aug. 8, 1861, it was mustered into the Confederate States service for one year. The battalion was increased to a regiment and known as Blythe's Regiment Mississippi Infantry, this designation being changed to 44th Regiment Mississippi Infantry by S. O. No. 135, A. & I. G. O., dated June 6, 1863.

About April 9, 1865, this regiment was consolidated with the 7th, 9th, 10th and 41st Regiments Mississippi Infantry and 9th Battalion Mississippi Sharp Shooters and formed a new regiment which was designated the 9th Regiment Mississippi Infantry.
