George Perry's will, dated 28th Jan 1823, Probated 24 March 1823. Wilkinson county, Mississippi  
To all people to whom these presents shall come I GEORGE PERRY do send greetings. Know ye that I the said GEORGE PERRY of Wilkinson county and state of Mississippi for and in consideration of the love, good will and affection which I have and do bear towards my well beloved wife and children, NANCY PERRY of the county and state aforesaid have given two hundred and thirty acres of land and one third of an acre laying in the county and state aforesaid  
bonded by IEDA DELOACH on the west and all my stock of cattle about thirty head and seven head of sheep and all my household and furniture to have and to hold he lifetime or during her widowhood and at her death to be equally divided  
between the heirs of her body, naming: JOHN PERRY, HULDAH PERRY, DAVID C. PERRY, SILAS PERRY, ELIZABETH PERRY, MARGARET PERRY, GEORGE PERRY, AMOS PERRY, or at the end of her widowhood to be equally divided between her and the afore named heirs of her body. I witness where of I have hereunto put my hand and seal this twenty eight day of Jan in the year of our Lord.  
signed and delivered in the present of  
William Overstreet, and John Perry.

Be it remembered that at a court of Probate held for the county aforesaid on the 24th day of March 1823 the foregoing  
last will and testament of GEORGE PERRY, decd. was probated in court by William Overstreet and John Perry the witnesses thereto who severally made oath that George Perry acknowledged the same as his last will and testament and  
that they as witness there to signed the same as witnesses in the presence of the Testator. Wherefore it is ordered that the  
same be recorded. T. H Proper, Judge of Probate
