Any man shall be eligible to membership in the Society who, being of the age of eighteen years or over, and a citizen of good reputs in the community, is the lineal descendant of an ancestor who was at all times unfailing in his loyalty to, and rendered active service in, the cause of American Independence, either as an officer, sodder, seaman, marine, militaman, or minute man, in the armed forces of the Continental Congress, or of any one of the several Colonies or States, or as a signer of the Declaration of Independence; or as a member of a Committee of Safety or Correspondence; or as a member of any Continental, Provincial, or Colonial Congress or Legislaturary or as a recognised parties who performed actual service by overt act of resistance the authority of the authority of the provincial and the contraction of the cont
