stands in the parlor above. And to Mary Chadwick my
younger daughter the sum of five pounds of good and
lawfull money of England. And to Anne Winterbottom my
eldest daughter the sum of twenty shillings. And all
the rest and remaining part of my goods after my just
debts and generall expences are payed I give to be
equally divided amongst my wife Rebecca Winterbottom
and my two sons Simeon Winterbottom and Robert
Winterbottom and Mary Chadwick my younger
daughter. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my
two sons Simeon Winterbottom and Robert Winterbottom
to be executors of this my last will and Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal the first day of November 1774.
