 deceased upon his entering into bond with security in the sum
 of Three hundred and Fifty dollars conditioned for the faithful
 performance of his trust, and William Frost and Daniel Bran-
 under being offered as securities are accepted by the Court -
 Whereupon the Court do order that Letters of Administration do
 issue to the said Daniel Berry the administrator aforesaid
 and the Court do appoint Henry Blose, James Woods & Thomas
 Smith appraisers to appraise the personal property of the said dec-
 Administrators sworn in open Court

Whereas Valentine Horn late of said County deceased died intestate
 and whilst he lived and at the time of his death disposed of certain
 goods and chattels right and credits money and effects, & building
 in your care and fidelity of Ezer Elliz Clerk as aforesaid, do by
 these presents make by order of said Court commit unto you full power
 and authority over all and singular the goods and chattels right
 credits money and effects of the said deceased well and truly to
 dispose of the same according to Law as also to ask gather receive
 and recover all and every debt and credit whatsoever of the said
 deceased which to him whilst he lived and at the time of his death
 did appertain. You are also to pay and discharge all and singular
 the debts dues and demands which the said deceased at the time
 of his death (including his funeral expenses) stood bound to pay
 according to the Laws of this State so far as the goods and chattels
 rights and credits money and effects come to your hands as will extend
 and for that purpose you are to call on each creditor of the deceased
 by public advertisement to exhibit to you their several claim
 claiming within one year from this date. You are also to make out
 a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods and
 chattels of the said deceased and have the same appraised by
 Henry, below James Tracy and Thomas Smith appraisers appointed
 by the Court and exhibit the same together with a correct list of
 the rights and credits money and effects of the said deceased to
 the said Court at the next term. You are also to make out a true
 and accurate account of your administration upon oath or affirmation
 and return the same to the said Court within one year from the
 date unless further time is granted by the Court for that purpose
 And by order of said Court I do in constitute and appoint
 you the said Daniel Tracy administrator over all and singular
 the goods and chattels right and credits money and effects of
 the said Valentine Horn deceased.
