

This Indenture Made the Twenty Ninth Day of September in the year of our
 Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & one Between Valentine Horne and Christiana his wife
 of the Township of Londonderry and County of Bedford & State of Pennsylvania of the
 One Part and Christian Albright of the Township of South Ampton and County of
 Somerset and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that whereas Jacob Ekenberger
 Obtained a Patent from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a certain Tract of one
 Hundred & Sixteen Acres of Lands called Gunstocks situate on the Waters of Gladders
 Run Londonderry Township and County aforesaid Beginning at an Ironwood stand
 running thence South forty seven perches to a white Oak thence South thirty nine Degrees
 Eighty four perches and two tenths to a post thence by River Lands and Vacant land north
 thirty two Degrees east one Hundred and forty three perches to a white Oak thence by Vacant
 Hills North twenty five Degrees West one Hundred and twenty seven perches and one
 half to a post from thence to the place of Beginning in a Straight Line containing sixty
 acres and the Allowance of six per cent be the same more or less which said land was surveyed in
 Pursuance of a warrant Dated the 18th of August one Thousand seven Hundred and eighty six
 and entered in the rolls office in said state in the patent Book No 18 page 126 -
 Referenced thereunto may more fully appear and he the said Ekenberger the said
 Mentioned tract did convey to Valentine Horne for and in Consideration of five pound
 lawful Money as by Indenture bearing Date the 24th Day of July 1891 and
 registered

Registered in the office in Bedford in Book 6 page 550 the Third Day of
 February 1792 Now this Indenture witnesseth the Said Valentine
 Horne & Christianna his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of seven tyne
 pounds lawful money of the said State to them in hand paid by Christian Albright
 aforesaid the receipt of ^{which} they do hereby Acknowledge hath Granted Bargained
 sold Assigned Released & Confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain Sell Assign
 Release and Confirm unto the said Christian Albright his Heirs and Assigns forever all
 that the before bounded Mentioned and Described part of a Tract of Land situate as
 aforesaid and Together with all and singular the Buildings Improvements ways
 Waters watercourses rights liberties privileges and Hereditaments whatsoever thereunto be-
 longing or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract or part of a
 Tract of Sixty Acres of Land and Alluance as the same is herein first before bounded
 and Described with the Hereditaments and Premises hereby Granted Bargained sold
 or Mentioned or Intended so to be with the Appurtenances unto the said Christian Al-
 bright his Heirs and Assigns to and for the only proper use benefit and behoof of him
 the said Christian Albright his Heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Valentine Horne
 and Christianna his wife for themselves their Heirs Executors and administrators do
 hereby Covenant grant and agree to and with the said Christian Albright his Heirs and
 Assigns that they the said Valentine Horne and Christianna his wife and their Heirs the
 heirs bargaineds premises and every part and parcel thereof to the said Christian Albright
 his heirs and Assigns And against them and their Heirs shall and will warrant and for-
 defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands
 and Affixed their Seals the Day and Year first above written
