James Cooper's will appears 13 August 1845 Book 3, p. 288 naming all the above children. He first lived in the Cottondale community then in the old Tyner community. He is presumed living in Tuscaloosa County by the time of the marriage of the son William Cooper 17 January 1822. James Cooper was active in the Whig Convention in 1840-42.
