

# HAMNER FAMILY

- No.1 THOMAS de MACCLESFIELD WAS BORN 1242 IN MACCLESFIELD, ENGLAND  
HE WAS AN OFFICER IN EDWARD 1 ARMY AND HELPED INVADE WALES IN 1277.  
HE WAS GRANTED THE LANDS COMPRISING THE PARISH OF HANMER IN WALES, FOR  
HIS SERVICE TO THE KING. HIS SON, SIR JOHN, WAS THE FIRST TO USE THE NAME  
HANMER AFTER THE LANDS HE INHERITED.
- No.2 JOHN de HANMER WAS BORN 1277 IN WALES AND DIED 1309.
- No.3 PHILP de HANMER WAS BORN IN WALES 1305.
- No.4 DAVID de HANMER WAS BORN 1332 IN WALES AND DIED 1383.
- No.5 JOHN HANMER WAS BORN 1361 IN WALES AND DIED 1427.
- No.6 EDWARD HANMER WAS BORN 1395 IN WALES.
- No.7 GRIFFITH HANMER WAS BORN 1429 IN WALES AND DIED 1501.  
HE MARRIED MARGARET LLOYD.
- No.8 JENKIN HANMER WAS BORN 1464 IN WALES.
- No.9 WILLIAM HANMER WAS BORN 1499 IN WALES AND DIED 1570 IN WALES  
HE MARRIED ELEANOR.
- No.10 WILLIAM HANMER WAS BORN 1529 IN WALES AND DIED 1589 IN WALES  
HE WAS MARRIED MARGARET KYNASTON.
- No.11 WILLIAM HANMER WAS BORN 1558 IN WALES AND DIED 1620 IN WALES  
HE MARRIED ELEANOR DYMCK
- No.12 HUMPHREY HAMNER- <sup>pg 63</sup>  
WAS BORN APRIL 29, 1592 IN WALES AND DIED JANUARY 1645 IN YORK COUNTY, VIRGINIA.  
HUMPHREY WAS THE FIRST IN THE FAMILY TO CHANGE HIS NAME FROM HANMER TO HAMNER.
- No.13 SR. NICHOLAS HAMNER BORN IN WALES 1650 - <sup>(about 1640)</sup>  
HE WAS BURIED IN BRUTON PARISH CHURCH YARDS WILLIAMSBURG, VA.
- No.14 JR. NICHOLAS HAMNER BORN 1670 NEW POQUASON PARISH YORK, CO. VIRGINIA.
- No.15 III NICHOLAS HAMNER 1703-1794 LIVED 91 YEARS JAMES CITY, CO. VIRGINIA. No
- No.16 WILLIAM HAMNER 1730-1788 LIVED 58 YEARS JAMES CITY CO. VA. No
- No.17 SR. TURNER HAMNER DEC. 27-1752-1845 LIVED 93
- No.18 JR. TURNER HAMNER BORN MAR. 1-1795 VA. 1851 TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA. 56 YEARS.
- No.19 JOHNSON HAMNER HE SERVED IN MILITARY APR. 4 1862 IN CO. TUSCALOOSA, CO. ALABAMA.  
HE REACHED THE RANK OF CORPORAL AND WAS CAPTURED OCT. 4-1863 IN WOODBURG  
TENNESSEE.
