

Know all men by these presents that we Joseph Dilley and Hezekiah McCoy are held and firmly bound unto James Monroe esquire governor of Virginia in the just and full sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to said Governor or his successors we bind our selves our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals and dated this 14th day of April 1802

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas there is a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between Joseph Dilley and Sarah McCoy Now if there be no lawful cause to obstruct the said marriage then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force power and virtue
