 of the County of Meigs and State of Virginia do
 order this my last Will and Testament as follows —
 Item It is my desire that my Loving Wife: Betty
 Thelkeld have and enjoy my two Negro Men nam-
 ly James & Robin during his natural life and
 after his death it is my desire that the two Negroes

Namely James & Robin be Equally divided by appren-
 tice between George & Daniel Threlkeld Sons of my
 Brother John Threlkeld also Thomas & William
 Threlkeld Sons of Moses Threlkeld Shear and ~~share~~
 alike between them four and their heirs for ever
 Except hereafter mentioned Also it is my desire that
 the said Nelly Threlkeld have and enjoy all my
 Personal Estate and at her death to be Equally
 divided between Daniel Threlkeld & Monky and
 Annand Lang that is to say my household
 Furniture & stock also leave to the said Daniel
 Threlkeld Monky our Negro boy named Joseph
 to be put to the Joiners Trade with the said Daniel
 and at the Expiration of the said Daniels appren-
 tice Ship then the said Daniel Threlkeld Monky
 take possession of the said Negro Joseph also
 my Warming Cloaths and two beds in the Town
 of Wexwick to him and his heirs forever And
 it is my desire that my Wife Nelly Threlkeld do
 pay either in Money or property the sum of fifty
 Pounds to Mary Kinkley Threlkeld and Richard
 Threlkeld Daughters of my Brother Henry Threlkeld
 for the Depreciation of the Paper money as my
 being Guardian to them & if they are satisfied with
 that sum then it is to be paid to them in twelve
 Months after my decease if not satisfied then it
 is not to be paid them and that if it being so they
 are to give Receipt lastly I appoint my Wife Nelly
 Threlkeld and my Brother John Threlkeld and John

John Waggoner Executor to this my Last Will and
 Testament In Witness I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this 31st day of Jan^y 1790
