 do hereby have this day Received from our Mother Nancy White our
 full share of the personal Estate of our said Father except the Negro man
 called a Schiller which said Negro man and our Interest in the real
 Estate of our said decas^d Father we receive in consideration of the sum
 of one Dollar to us in hand paid and of the Love and affection we have
 for our said mother Relinquish to her and convey the here rents and
 profits which may accrue during her natural life, widow hood but in
 case our said mother should marry again then and in that case
 within twelve months then after she shall have her third part
 of according to law without accounting for the here Rents and
 profits of said negro man in said Partition Previous to said period
 and any just debts which our s^d mother may pay shall be allow^d
 to her as we have no farther claim against her for any thing more
 from the personal Estate of our said Father our hands and Seals this 30th day
 of January 1824

This Indenture made the 7th day of June in the year
 of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty four
 between George Thutthild and Elizabeth his wife of the County
 of Warren and State of Kentucky of the One part and
 Walter Behou of the County & State aforesaid of the Other
 Witnesseth that the sd George Thutthild & Elizabeth his wife
 For and in consideration of the just and full sum of
 Twelve Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained &
 sold to the sd Walter Behou & has had a certain tract
 or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Warren
 and in the said State of Kentucky a branch of Ball Run
 containing by survey five & a half acres more or less
 bounded as follows viz, Beginning at a red oak
 white Oak in the old line between sd Thutthild
 & Behou about six poles from said run on the N. side
 thence s 70° N 36° poles to a drain in the land of Stone
 thence up sd drain N 56° W 30° poles to the drain of
 a spring down but from the spring near the corner
 of sd Behou's land thence south 30° N 14° poles to a red
 oak sapling in the old line thence E 58° 30° to the
 beginning & have and to hold sd tract or parcel of land
 to the sd Walter Behou and his heirs forever and the sd
 George Thutthild & Elizabeth Covenant, with the sd Behou
 & his heirs for themselves and their heirs that they will
 forever warrant and defend sd tract of land with it
 & appurtenances from the claims of them & their heirs
