THIS INDENTURE made the Twenty third day of October in the fifth year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord George the Second by the grace of God of Great Brittain France and Ireland, King, Defender of the faith acc., And in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty one; Between JOHN REEDS of the Parish of Washington in the County of Westmorland, Planter, of one part and JOHN JETT JUNR. of the Parish of Sittingbourn in County of KING GEORGE, Planter of the other part; Wittneseth that JOHN REEDS in consideration of the sum of Nine pounds currant money of Virginia to him in hand paid by JOHN JETT, JUNR., the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto JOHN JETT, JUNR. being in his actual! possession now being by virtue of a bargain and sale for one whole year and by force of the Statute for transferring uses into possession, one track of land situate in Parish of Washington in County of Westmorland at the head of MATTOX CREEK, Beginning (the bounds of the land are repeated as in the Lease); To have and to hould all the premises unto JOHN TETT. JUNR, and his heirs; And JOHN REEDS his heirs &. the land and premise doth warrant to JOHN JEIT JUNR his heirs against all manner of persons; In Wittness whereof the said JOHN REEDS hath hereunto sett his hand & seal the day month & year

Lease of 100 acres, part of Elkwood ... corner to another lott of the said Gett's ... For lives of John Gett and Stephen his son and James Jett his son and the longest liver. Yearly rent, 474 pounds of tobacco on 27 November.

If. Gett shall work more than two tithables besides himself, to pay for every tithable beside the two and himself 105 Pounds of tobacco additional rent. John Gett shall keep an orchard of one hundred good apple trees in good repair well fenced safe from cattle, horses, goats and sheep and will keep all houses in good repair. W. Beverley

COPTON Esqr. of Great Britain by the Right Honourble THOMAS LORDFAIRFAX  
Proprietor of the Northern Neck of Virginia and by the said COMPTON was sold to  
William Roberts and the said 242 acres is Bounded Beginning at a white oak corner to  
BENJAMIN GUINN ran south side of Battle Run and runs thence corner to FRANCIS  
WALL  
thence with his line to four pines on a Ridge to two pines corner to Chapman and  
Benjamin  
Guinn thence with Guinn's line to the Beginning ..
