

This Indenture made this twelfth day  
 of June Eighteen hundred and four between Joseph  
 Allen of the County of Lincoln and State of Kentucky of  
 the one part and Charles Lynch of the County of Shelby  
 and State of Kansas of the other part Witnesseth that  
 for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in  
 hand paid by the said Charles Lynch the receipt whereof  
 is hereby Acknowledged hath bargained and sold (and  
 by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the  
 said Charles Lynch Four Hundred Acres of Land as  
 the waters of Little Bullskin and Floyd Forks it being  
 the West end of an Eight hundred Acre Tract

of Land Granted to said Helm by the State of Virginia wherein William Mas and Thomas Shanks now live that is to say they live on the East end of said Eight hundred Acre Tract to have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land containing four hundred Acres that is to say the west end of said Eight hundred Tract of Land which is to be split by a line as near to the middle as can be and to split by a North and South line and the said Joseph Helm and his heirs servants with the said Charles Lynch and his heirs that he the said Joseph Helm for himself and his heirs doth hereby Relinquish to the said Charles Lynch and his heirs all his right title and Interest to the said four Hundred Acres of Land to the said Charles Lynch and his heirs forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the date the date above written
