to God for it calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once for to die do make and ordain this
my Last Will and Testament that is for to say principally and first
of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of God that
gave it and for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried
in Decent and a Christian like manner at the discretion of my
executors hereafter mentioned Nothing I doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
powers of God as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal it
hath pleased God to bless me with in this world I give and devise
and dispose of the same in the following manner. In witness
it is my will and I do order that in the first place all my just

debts and funeral charges be paid and satisfied - Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved and loving wife Margaret Helm fifteen pounds current money a year along with her and Margaret Helm liveth her bed and furniture also her saddle and bridle and one negro Woman named Hannah. Item I give and bequeath unto my youngest Son Thomas Helm the plantation whereon I now live on the west side of Bruckow containing two hundred and sixty nine acres of land and likewise the tract joining it on the East side of Bruckow containing three hundred and twenty acres of land and another certain tract of land lately surveyed by Mr Richard Ryop joining the plantation whereon I now live on the west side of Bruckow and one negro named Peter and one young mare of scarl color unto him my said Son Thomas Helm and heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my other Sons and Daughters all the remainder part of my Estate after my debts and legacies are paid to be equally divided among my Children John Meredith Joseph and William Helm Ann Hunter now wife Henry Hunter Jane Margaret Elizabeth Helm that is for to say three hundred and sixty five acres of land nowe by the name of the Quaker two hundred and ninety five acres land lying in Frederick County as bought of Richard Chapman the said two tracts of land to sold and the money arising thereby to be equally divided between my Sons and daughters John Meredith Joseph and William Helm Ann Hunter now wife Henry Hunter Jane Margaret and Elizabeth Helm and that my Sons Meredith and Joseph Helm hold and possess all the Estate I have bequeathed to my Son Thomas Helm untill he my said Son Thomas Helm comes to the age of twenty one years old and that my said sons meredith and Joseph Helm have all the profit the a said meredith and Joseph Helm can make of off the said plantation mill and still untill my Son Thomas comes of age and likewise my said Sons meredith and Joseph Helm give their Mother a sufficient mantenance or fifteen pounds a year as before mentioned which she shall choose and likewise to maintain my Daughter Jane Margaret and Elizabeth untill each of them shall arrive to the age of seventeen years old and further that the said meredith and Joseph Helm give their Brother Thomas Helm

a sufficient Education and maintenance untill he shall come to
the age of twenty one years at which time the said Mere doth and Joseph
Helm shall deliver unto him the said brother Thomas Helm the
plantations mill and still as unto him bequeathed and before mentioned
in good and sufficient order and Repair and it is my will that
if any of my Children should die before they com of age that his or her
Legacies be equally divided between the remainder of my Children
John Mereloth Joseph and William and Thomas Helm Jane Margaret
and Elizabeth Helm Lastly I leave an affoint my sons Mere doth
and Joseph Helm wheli and sole Executor of this my last Will
and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this 16 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred seventy six sealed signed and delivered in presence of
