my Last will and Testament in manner and form following: first and

through the merits and mediation of my Blessed Saviour and Redemer
Jesus Christ and my body I desire may be Decently buried at the Discretion
of my Executor and as for such temporal Estate as the Lord in his
great goodness and mercy hath entrusted me to be Steward of. I give
Devise and Dispose thereof as follows. I give and bequeath to my
youngest Daughter Philothia Learning all my household furniture
and twenty pounds of my other moveable Estate. also I give and
bequeath to my 2^d Daughter Philothia my black silk gown — I give
and bequeath to my oldest Daughter Anna Roberts my Chinese gown
black apron and bonnet. — also I give and bequeath to my 2^d Daughter
Anna twenty Shillings out of my moveable Estate — I give and
bequeath to my second Daughter Abigail Adams my Dark-Colored
gown and Silk Cloak also I give and bequeath to my 2^d Daughter
Abigail twenty Shillings out of my moveable Estate —
I give and bequeath to my third Daughter Annia Brounster.
Roberts. my Gown Head and twenty Shillings of my moveable
Estate. and also it is my will that my other wearing apparel
be Equally Divided to my said four Daughters Anna Roberts
Abigail Adams Annia Brounster. Roberts. and Philothia Learning —
I do give and bequeath all the Remainder of my Estate to my two
Sons Judah Learning and David Learning particulars when my Debts
are paid and a Defunt pair of Roomstones for my Late Husband
Mathias Learning Dec^d and also a pair of Defunt Roomstones
for my self which is my will to be performed by my Executor out

of my Estate - and I do hereby will and appoint that my Executor
 Shall by and out of my Estate Retain and Satisfy himself all such
 costs and charges as he shall be put unto in the Execution of this
 my will. and I do hereby Declare this only to be my Last
 will and Testament and I do appoint Executors of Bristol in the
 County of Hartford Executors thereof - In Witness whereof I the said
 Philotheca Learning have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 20th
 Day of November 1797. - Philotheca Learning
