

You will want to read the article "Joost Goderis, New Amsterdam Burgher, Weighmaster, and Dutch Master Painter's son" by Elva Kathleen Lyon. It appeared in the October 1992 issue of "The New York Genealogical & Biographical Record", Volume 123, Number 4, pages 193-202....

Joost was the son of Johannes/Hans Goderis and Tanneken van Goorel/Gorel, the daughter of Hans van Gorel from Brabant and Josyntie Gelis.

Johannes Goderis was a master painter of marine and river scenes in the early 1600s. He was the son of Joris Godderis -- who lived in Haarlem but who was originally from Paschendale in Flanders (now in Belgium) -- and his wife, Maurintgen Lybaerts. They were married before 1600.

In the last paragraph of the article cited above the author says, "[Joost Goderis ... and his wife Jocomijntie Frans ... may also have had] a daughter "Catharina Guderis", wife of Jeremiah Kettel..."
