In the Name of God amen. I Henry Huber of Lower Milford Town-
ship in the County of Bucks in the State of Penn^a. Shoemaker being
very sick and weak in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory thanks
be given unto GOD Calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body &
knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die do make & ordain this
my Last Will & Testament that is to say principally & First of all I
recomend my Soul into the Hands of almighty God that gave it and
my Body I recomend to the Earth to be buried in a decent and Christian
Burial at the Discretion of my Exec^{rs}. hereunto mentioned nothing
doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty Power of God and as touching and concerning my
wordly Estate wherewith it has pleased GOD to bless me in this Life I
give devise and dispose of the same in the following Manner and Form.
First I give and bequeath to my well beloved Wife Anna Huborn. the
whole new House to her own Use Residence and Dwelling. Further
Fifty Pounds ready Money which shall be paid to her soon after my
Disease. Further my own Bed & Chest further a Chest and all what
is therein. Further all my linnen Cloth so well Flax as Towes. Further
three Pounds more or less of Cotton Further. 3 pewter Plates and two
pewter Dishes. for the s^d five pieces of Pewter Gears she shall have the
Chaise of all my pewter Gears. Further two Couze which she choose of
my Cows further the Clock and Iron Stove with the Pipes in the New
House. Further a halfe Gallon Bodles & quart Bodles all the Wheat
and Ric in the Barn. all the Meal at present in the whole House Fur-
ther two Iron Pots which she please. two pans which she please. two wash-
ing Tubs two ^{pails} which she please. two Spining Wheels. all the Leather in the
House. the Bible Book the true Christian Book the Haven Letter Book.
a Long Book. the Tea put and all the Cups to. a halfe dozen of pewter
Spoons. to take which she please. Further the Bags wherewin it is the above
mentioned Meal together all the other. Bags. Flesh Forks one. Scissors
one. and a Iron broil Spoon And further. I give and bequeath all
my

my Estate Except. what is made and bequeath. to my present Wife
 Ana afores. to my two Brothers Henry Huber & Jacob Huber both
 Taylors. in equal Shares. Except. the Burn Hettle I likewise give and
 bequeath to my well beloved Wife Ana. afores. mentioned And I
 constitute ordain & make to my Executors of this my Last Will and
 Testament my well beloved Friends Adam Willower and Valentin
 Huber both of the s^d Township and I do hereby utterly disallow re-
 voke & disannul all & every other & former Testaments & Wills Legacies
 & Executors by me in any ways before named willed and bequeathed
 ratifying and confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testa-
 ment. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
 this Sixteenth Day of December in the Year of our Lord God One
 Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Seven. —
