 Brink for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and
 fifty Dollars well and truly paid by said Thomas Hays the
 receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they the Parties of
 the first part have granted bargained and sold aliened the same
 And by the presents all great power all claim and demand
 due to Samuel Hays his heirs and assigns all that certain
 Tract of land situate and being in the Township of Westchester
 and is called & bounded as follows at a certain Maple Tree
 standing on the South of Delaware River it being also a Tree of
 the land of John Westbrooke Thence South Eighty six Degrees
 East One Chain & fifty Links Thence South fifty two Degrees
 East thirty six Links Thence South thirteen Degrees East thirty
 Minutes Eighty seven Links Thence South twenty Degrees East
 forty Links Thence North eighty eight Degrees forty five Minutes East
 eighty nine Links North seventy six Degrees East One Chain seven
 Links South twenty Degrees East twenty seven Links Thence
 South Thence South fifty Degrees and thirty Minutes East One
 Chain Thence South eighty eight Degrees twenty five Minutes East
 One Chain Thence South twenty five Degrees East twenty Links
 Thence South forty seven Degrees forty Minutes East eighty Links
 Thence South thirty five Degrees thirty Minutes East One Chain Thence

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South forty six Degrees East One Chain Hence South seventy three
 Degrees East fifty Links Hence North fifty eight Degrees East
 One Chain to a second Station Hence South forty three Degrees
 and thirty Minutes East fifty seven Links Hence South sixteen
 Degrees East thirty three Links Hence North thirty four Degrees
 East thirty three Links Hence South seventy one Degrees fifty Minutes
 East twelve Chains forty eight Links to a third Station Hence
 South fifty nine Degrees East five Chains and fourteen Links to
 a Chestnut marked and standing on the West side of the Kings
 highway Hence South fifty nine Degrees West fourteen Chains &
 eighty Links to a marked Hickory standing Hence South forty two
 and twenty Minutes West thirty eight Chains and seventy four
 Links Hence North forty eight Degrees East fifteen Chains &
 forty Links to a large Hickory Tree standing in the Field on the
 Bank of the old Delaware River Hence up along the S^d River
 the Subscriptors there to the first mentioned Table Line at the
 bearing containing about one hundred and fifty Acres to the
 same more or less and also all lands Meadows Trees Woods
 under Woods Fishes common and Pastures Groves Waters Ways
 pastures, pastures Hereditaments &c. Appurtenances whatsoever
 to the S^d Tract of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining
 and the several persons and persons of the State and people of the
 Province and every part thereof possessing or having right thereof
 whether in the present or to be written the boundaries of the
 aforesaid Tract of Land) Together with all the State Right Title Interest
 properly claim and demand whatsoever of them the S^d Anna
 Brink and the rest of the Parties of the first part and of their heirs
 Executors Administrators and assigns and to the said Tract and parcel of Land
 and every part thereof To have and to hold the S^d Tract &
 parcel of Land and all and singular the Premises above mentioned
 and every part and parcel thereof except the ten Acres as above
 expressed with the appurtenances unto the S^d Manuel Hoyer
 his heirs and assigns to the only proper Use and behoof of the
 S^d Manuel Hoyer his heirs and assigns for ever And the S^d
 Anna Brink Nicholas Brink &c. rest of the Parties of the
 first part for them and their heirs jointly the S^d Tract of Land
 and premises and every part thereof against them and their heirs &c.
 against all and every other person whatsoever to the S^d Manuel
 Hoyer his heirs and assigns shall and will Warrant and for ever
 Defend Maintain whosoever the S^d Anna Brink and the rest of the

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Parties of the first part have unto these presents voluntarily set
 their hands and affixed their seals the day and Year Month & Year
