- **Note:** He served in 1758 during the French and Indian War in Capt. William Paige's Company of Hardwick and in 1762 in the Company of Capt. William Shepard. He marched from Brookfield on April 19, 1755 under command of Capt. Jonathan Barnes, serving 16 days. He later served for 8 months under Capt. John Packard, and again in April 1778 enlisted for 9 months service, receiving a bounty of 100 pounds and the "use of a blanket". In 1818, he recieved a pension for his Revolutionary War Service.
